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Sani Pass & Roof of Africa



Originally developed in 1913 as a bridal path the Sani Pass was first negotiated with a vehicle in 1948 and is now the only access from KZN into the Lesotho Highlands, better known as the "Roof of Africa". The route through the Lesotho highlands consists of the highest roads in Africa and the third highest in the world peaking at 3200m at places!

The trip will commence around the town of Underberg, heading up Sani Pass (with a stopover at the highest pub in Africa). A 200 km (six hour) drive will lead through the "Roof of Africa" to the Katse Dam. The route will continue through Lesotho to Fouriesburg where the trip will conclude. A valid passport will be required.

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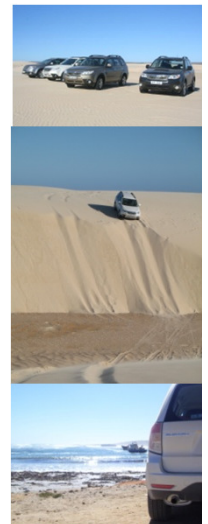
